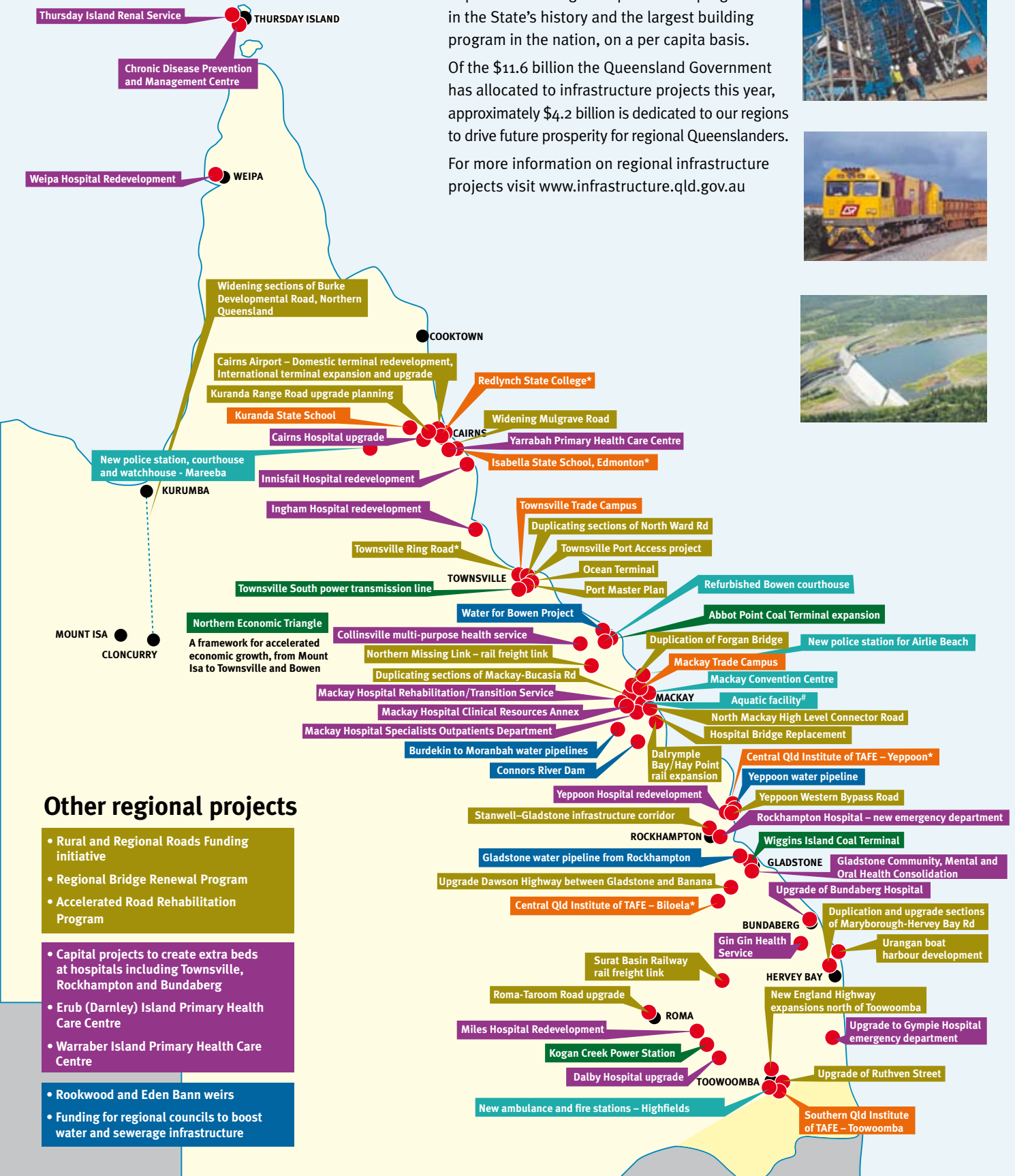


# Regional infrastructure projects
